Speech	3 Semester Hours	<i>COMM 201 Public Speaking and Rhetorical Persuasion</i>
Psychology	3 Semester Hours	<i>PSYC 101 Principles of Psychology</i>
Social Science	9 Semester Hours	Includes anthropology, economics, history, human geography, political science, psychology, and sociology. Recommend ECON 195 Macroeconomics, ECON 325 Microeconomics, HIST 300 20 th Century World History, HUSS 120 Public Health Issues, SOSC 102 Principles of Sociology, SOSC 301 Interpersonal Relations and Group Dynamics, and any other psychology course.
Arts or Humanities	9 Semester Hours	Includes history, language, literature, philosophy, religious and cultural studies, performing and visual arts history or appreciation. Recommend any philosophy course, HUSS 130 Cultural Competence in Human Services, HUMA 315 Topics in World Civilization: Early Comparative Cultures.

In addition, 30 elective credits in General Education, Liberal Arts, Life Sciences, or Physical Sciences are required for a total of 60 semester hours (90 quarter hours). Prerequisite courses must transfer at the baccalaureate level with a minimum 2.0 on a 4.0 scale. Cumulative GPA must be a minimum of 2.0 on a 4.0 scale. Please refer to the National University of Health Sciences *Bulletin* regarding additional admission requirements.
