English	6 Semester Hours	<i>ENG 1061 English Composition</i> <i>ENG 3101 Rhetoric and Composition</i>
Speech	3 Semester Hours	<i>ENG 1070 Effective Speaking</i>
Psychology	3 Semester Hours	<i>PSY 1010 Introduction to Psychology</i>
Social Science	9 Semester Hours	Includes anthropology, economics, history, human geography, political science, psychology, and sociology.
Arts or Humanities	9 Semester Hours	Includes history, language, literature, philosophy, religious and cultural studies, performing and visual arts history or appreciation.

In addition, 30 elective credits in General Education, Liberal Arts, Life Sciences, or Physical Sciences are required for a total of 60 semester hours (90 quarter hours). Prerequisite courses must transfer at the baccalaureate level with a minimum 2.0 on a 4.0 scale. Cumulative GPA must be a minimum of 2.0 on a 4.0 scale.
